This includes working closely with school contacts and preparing, delivering and overseeing SHIFT (Sexual Health & Intimacy for Teens) presentations. This role is also responsible for the development of new branches of the program, such as elementary schools and other groups as the opportunity arises.

The ideal candidate is an experienced educator, has strong presenting skills, has a passion for leading youth, and is enthusiastic about our mission.

Major Responsibilities:

Thriving in a role that involves presenting to elementary, middle and high school students, this qualified candidate will:

- > Prepare, maintain and update SHIFT presentations covering relevant sexual health topics, and ensure compliance with BC learning outcomes.
- > Research and develop new presentations and curriculum, as needed, pertaining to sexual health education at every grade level.
- > Make contact with relevant teachers, administrative staff, and/or principals to inform them about the nature and benefits of SHIFT presentations.
- > Schedule SHIFT presentations and follow-up with teachers before and after the presentations.
- > Deliver SHIFT presentations and coordinate any SHIFT presenters (Contracted and Staff).
- > Develop curriculum and presentations for elementary grades under the brand of SAFE (Self Awareness For Everyone).
- > Recruit, train, and supervise contract and staff SHIFT/SAFE presenters.

- > Conduct staff and contractor reviews to evaluate their performance and recommend pay increases when applicable.
